Declining services and an increasing population of older people and others who need support, leave many people vulnerable, socially isolated and unable to access the essential services and social activities that enable them to maintain an independent and enjoyable life style.

Link Schemes draw on the goodwill already existing in communities to provide a voluntary good neighbour service. Volunteering has many benefits for individuals and communities and vulnerable residents receive a much valued service.

Link Schemes provide a free confidential service but welcome donations from their users. All donations are used in the provision of the service which is run entirely by volunteers.

The Link Scheme is run entirely by volunteers to assist members of the community who need help with transport, a little assistance with daily living tasks to make life easier or need a little companionship.
